A Levels (Advanced Level Qualifications) are the British equivalent of the Baccalaureate (Year 12 and Year 13), recognised worldwide for their academic rigour and excellent preparation for university. Designed for students aged 16 to 18, A Levels allow for in-depth specialisation in subjects of interest, fostering independence, critical thinking, and academic mastery in key areas.

#### **International Recognition**


A Levels are highly regarded by universities in the UK, Europe, Canada, and the US, as well as by top-tier educational institutions worldwide. This qualification opens doors to global academic opportunities, facilitating entry into highly competitive degree programmes.

At MAGNO School, we offer A Levels in collaboration with the prestigious UK-based National Extension College (NEC), through a hybrid model that combines:

- Flexibility for students to progress at their own pace, without sacrificing academic rigour or human interaction.



# **SPANISH UNIVERSITY**

Students enrolled in A Level programme at MAGNO can gain direct access to Spanish universities thanks to official recognition by the Ministry of Education.

#### **Important note:**

MAGNO does not offer preparation for the Pruebas de Competencias Específicas (PCE – Specific Skills Tests). As a result:

- The maximum university entrance score in Spain will be 10 out of 14 if the student only takes A Levels.
- To qualify for higher cut-off scores (up to 14 points), students may choose to sit PCE exams in two additional subjects independently, ideally with external support.


The entire admission process is managed through **UNED** (Universidad Nacional de Educación a Distancia), with guidance and support from our Head of Stage and School Secretary, who advises each student according to their academic goals.

## **UNIVERSITY ABROAD**

A Levels are widely recognized by universities around the world as a rigorous and respected qualification. Originating in the UK, A Levels are now accepted by institutions in many countries including the United States, Canada, Australia, Germany, Singapore and the Netherlands. Each individual country and university will have different entry requirements, but all will look favourably on students who have successfully completed A level paths of study.

Students typically take A Levels in three to four subjects, and strong performance can open doors to top-tier universities where grades will be considered alongside other factors like personal statements, references, and standardized test scores (where applicable).

# General Conditions A LEVEL FEES 25-26

#### **General Terms and Conditions:**

- Enrolment Fee for New Students Only: €650 (one-off payment for the entire school life)
- Annual Non-Refundable Place Reservation Fee for All Students: €360. The place reservation fee includes:
  - **Excursions:** Cultural excursions are included in the place reservation fee and attendance is compulsory.
  - **School Insurance:** School insurance is included in the place reservation fee.
- Items Included in the School Fees:
  - Tuition
  - Technology Fee
- **School Dining Service:** The school dining service is compulsory for all students.
- Monthly Fee Payments: Payments will only be accepted via direct debit.
- Review of Fees: Fees are reviewed annually and come into effect on 1st September of each academic year.
- **Sibling Discounts:** A 5% discount on tuition will be applied to the second child enrolled, and a 15% discount on tuition for the third and subsequent children.
- Early Payment Discount: A 2% discount will be applied to the annual tuition fee if payment is made before 31st July 2025 by bank transfer to the following account:

**IMPORTANT:** Please indicate your child's name and year group as the reference and email proof of payment to **info@magnoschool.es** along with a copy of the transaction receipt.

- **Returned Direct Debits:** Any returned direct debit payment will incur a charge of €6. Any invoice unpaid after 15 days will be considered a debt to the school and will accrue interest at a rate of 3% on the outstanding amount.
- **Uniform Policy:** The use of the school uniform is compulsory at all stages. The old and new uniforms may be worn concurrently until September 2026. From September 2026, only the new uniform will be permitted.
- External Examinations: Fees for external examinations are not included.
- **Overnight Trips:** Trips involving overnight stays will incur an additional cost.
- Books and School Supplies: These are not included in the tuition fee.
- A-Levels **Exam fees** will entail an additional cost of approximately €600.
